Additional notes:	Please note that this is a 'live in' position and due to employment regulations a UK National Insurance number is required. A clean, full driving license is a requirement as the role involves driving. A valid First Aid qualification is also required.

At each of our Summer Camps and Family Adventure Holidays we provide 1.5 hours of sports or outdoor activity sessions every morning and up to 4hrs of adventurous activities every afternoon. Summer Camps last for a duration of 10 days (Sat-Tues) and Family Adventure Holidays last for 7 days (Sat – Sat).

This role requires the planning and providing of a range of activities on a daily basis for the 1.5 hours morning sports/activity sessions. Experience in coaching and teaching and outdoor industry qualifications are advantageous. Candidates must have an enthusiasm for the outdoors and have the ability to inspire, support and educate through the organisation and delivering of the sports/activity sessions. Mountain Adventure Camps operate in an alpine climate, so it is essential that all activities are planned and delivered to ensure that potential risks are managed proactively.

This role also requires involvement in the afternoon sessions where you will work with fully qualified 3rd party providers in delivering safe and educational adventure activities; such as white water rafting, mountain biking and stand up paddle boarding.

All activity sessions are designed to help improve skills and confidence and as holders of the UK Governments Department for Education's LoTC Quality Badge, development and learning during the sessions is essential. In house training in the facilitation and delivering of sessions will be provided, along with on-going support to ensure that sessions meet strict guidelines provided by the British Activity Providers Association (BAPA) and the Adventure Activity Industry Committee (AAIAC).

Activity Leaders are also involved in other areas of the camp and a clean, full UK driving license is a requirement as the role involves driving. This is a demanding role and it is an expectation that you will work outside of a scheduled routine. However, this is also a rewarding position that will provide you with a unique and cultural experience.
