Mountain Adventure Camps is looking for a bright, inventive and proactive Group Leader to join their summer team in the French Alps.

As an individual, you will be one of the critical factors in ensuring that guests in your care have an unforgettable, once-in-a-lifetime experience. You will be the dedicated point of contact for the children of which you are to mentor and lead. This role is extremely good fun and very rewarding, whilst at the same time demanding. However, with the range of resources and outstanding activities on offer this should be a pleasure.

In addition, you will be involved in other areas of the summer camp to ensure that the camp operates efficiently and effectively (light daily cleaning duties, part responsibility of chalet changeover between sessions). You will also accompany the group on all activities and excursions (white water rafting, mountain biking, mountain walks etc.), providing encouragement and motivation where necessary.

Mountain Adventure Camps Group Leaders need to have a positive attitude to work and a genuine interest in children and young people. The ability to build a good rapport with children is important. You should have an open mind and be tolerant of all cultures, races and languages. Above all you should be a team player who is kind, caring and great fun!

It is beneficial if you have experience working with children, first aid training and are keen on sports and the outdoors. This position will require specific business relationships with local, regional, and national professional or related organisations and businesses.

Our Summer Camp sessions last for a duration of 10 days (Sat-Tues) and the Group Leader daily routine will be based on the following;

- First and foremost, have fun!
- Attend informal morning meeting before waking children. Clarify plan for the day, discuss issues from previous day or night
- Ensure children are woken up, washed, dressed and ready for agreed breakfast time
- Encourage a light hearted and fun room inspection, ensuring beds are made, clothes put away, towels hung up and radiators turned off
- Join children at breakfast table, engage in conversation, monitor behaviour, explain to them the plan for the day
- Assist in escorting the children to sports or language lesson
- Join children at lunch, engage in conversation, monitor behaviour, explain to them the clothing required for the afternoon session

- Partake in the afternoons activities (white water rafting etc.) and reassure any children that are worried and assist guides when necessary
- Upon returning from activity, help supervise children during free time
- Join children at dinner, engage in conversation, monitor behaviour, explain to them evening activity
- Assist on rota basis for evening activity

As holders of the UK LOtC Quality Badge, development and learning during the sessions is essential. Mountain Adventure Camps aims to turn learning into an enjoyable experience for the children, so that they may benefit in an approach that is not possible from home.
