Mountain Adventure Camps is looking for a bright, inventive and proactive Language Teacher to teach both English and French as part of their summer team in the French Alps.

As an individual, you will be one of the critical factors in ensuring that guests in your care have an unforgettable, once-in-a-lifetime experience. You will be responsible for planning, facilitating and delivering educational and fun language lessons (English and French) that last for 1.5hrs per day (3 x 45 minute sessions) and you will have loco parentis of those in your care.

In addition, you will be involved in other areas of the summer camp to ensure that the camp operates efficiently and effectively. You will also accompany the group on all activities and excursions (whitewater rafting, mountain biking, mountain walks etc), including encouraging and motivating guests to use their new language where necessary.

Candidates need to have a fine, working knowledge of both the English and French language (level C1 or C2). The ability to teach and to make language learning fun, engaging and inspiring is also a desirable quality.

Summer Camp sessions last for a duration of 10 days (Sat-Tues) and the guests have lessons Sunday through to the following Monday. As each guest may have varying levels of education regarding the English and French language, it is important that lessons can be adapted to all members of the group.

As holders of the UK LOtC Quality Badge, development and learning during the sessions is essential. Mountain Adventure Camps aims to turn language learning into an enjoyable experience for the children, so that they may benefit in an approach that is not possible from home. The lessons need to take the children outside the classroom so they can put their learning into practice.

The language teacher would work alongside the Centre Manager to ascertain the levels of the children each session, using an assessment lesson and determine whether the children can be taught in one group or should be split.

Previous experience in teaching and working with children is required along with a keen interest in sports and the outdoors. Applicants must also be confident in leading a small class of students (up to a maximum 10).

This is a fantastic opportunity to teach small groups of students in a delightful environment.
